As the academic year draws to a close, I would like to take the opportunity to remind the community about a number of our school expectations and procedures in preparation for 2018.

Students will return for the 2018 academic year on the following dates:

#### **Student Devices**

All students must bring a fully charged device everyday. New students and parents purchasing a new/updated device are asked to supply their child with a laptop meeting the attached specifications. We have moved away from the iPad due to limitations in studies, as well as the interruptions to learning. The minimum size screen is 13". No android/tablets are permitted.

Next year students will need to take more responsibility for their devices. We would always recommend a hard style protective case for all laptops. Many students are not using these protective measures. A student should know where his/her device is at all times. Installing Apps such as 'Where is my device' are often recommended by Police. Including the device as a portable item on home content insurance to cover damage is always suggested. For apple devices, the AppleCare Protection Plan to cover damage is worth considering. The school cannot be held liable for any damage to a personally owned device. Students who break/damage school property will be given a bill to repair the damage/device.

#### Mobile phones:



Mobile phone use is strictly prohibited during class.

Failure to comply will lead to confiscation.

A large number of the students are not respecting the school rules in regard to appropriate mobile phone use.

During classtimes the mobile phone MUST be switch off.

This includes students in the library and all school areas. No exceptions. If a parent/carer needs to urgently call a message can be left at the front office. We urgently need parent support as recently a number of videos/images have been posted online that have required reporting to police due to student safety. Students who do not follow the rules will be asked to leave their phone at the front office for safe keeping and parental collection.

School Shoes: We need parents/carers to be careful in the selection purchase of appropriate shoes for school and the site. Traditional leather lace up solid heel, polishable school shoes must be worn. School shoes must meet Workplace Health & Safety guidelines.

Not permitted: Canvas, skating/running shoes with a flat sole, open top shoes similar to Mary Jane style, or shoes with decorative hole patterns (that would allow liquid in) are not permitted.

Styles that are NOT suitable for wearing at St Clare's



Earrings/piercings: Only girls are permitted to wear one small sleeper/stud in the lower ear lobe. Plastics spacers/keepers are never suitable at St Clare's. Facial piercings do not form part of our uniform expectations at any time. Band-aids/patches are also not acceptable to cover such items.

School Travel: It is the expectation of the NSW Government that all students are carrying and using a valid Opal Card for transport. If a travel pass is issued to a student/family it must be tapped on and tapped off. Students who do not use the system correctly may find a service cut back or withdrawn by the system. If students do not have an Opal Card the full fare must be paid to the driver. Teachers on bus duty cannot negotiate with the driver/bus company. These are the conditions of student travel. Carbonated Caffeine/Energy Drinks: these drinks are not permitted on school grounds due to the inherent risks associated with consuming large volumes posing serious health problems. illness and fatalities. It concerns us that some students are consuming these before school.

Before/After School: Students are expected to travel directly to and from school. There should be no loitering or gathering at the local Shopping Plaza.

### **Requirements Checklist**



The following specifications outline Bring Your Own Learning Tool (BYOLT) models, permitted to connect to the CEDP ICT network. In addition:

- 1. All BYOLT authorised to connect to the CEDP ICT network are required to be enrolled;
- 2. **Enrolled** Bring Your Own Learning Tools automatically receive the necessary settings to connect to the CEDP ICT network:
- 3. Not enrolled Bring Your Own Learning Tools will not be able to access the Internet via the CEDP ICT network;
- 4. For the purpose of network security/management and student safety, user identification, device specifications and application data is captured via the enrolment process; and
- 5. CEDP reserves the right to temporarily or permanently **restrict or prevent** any Bring Your Own Learning Tool connecting to the CEDP ICT network.




#### **Devices & Operating Systems**

- Apple Laptop OS 10.9 or above
- Chromebooks latest Chrome OS
- Windows Tablet / Laptop Windows 10



#### Wireless Connectivity

- Devices must support:
  - wireless frequencies (2.4 GHz & 5 GHz)
  - 802.11 "a", "g", "n" and/or "ac" wireless standards
    - WPA2 enterprise security



#### Screen Size

Ensure the screen size is of a reasonable size not less than 9 Inches (23cm) and a resolution of 600 dpl to enable ease of use throughout the school day



#### Hardware Features

- A camera/video camera and microphone is necessary to ensure students can participate in 21st century learning activities

6hrs minimum battery life - the device needs to last a full school day



A stylus or keyboard is optional though may be useful

    Chromebooks 16GB storage and 1GB RAM

    Laptops 128GB storage and 4GB RAM
