You invite us to repentance at Lent by engaging more honestly, genuinely and deeply in prayer.


Teach us, through the example of St Clare's spirit of contemplation, to develop authentic prayerfulness - so that "we may desire to imitate him who is perfect".

Vaping

Over the past few weeks we have been raising concerns about the number of our students who are involved in vaping at school, but also traveling to and from school. This continues to be a problem. Most recently we have had groups of students congregating at Hassall Grove shops.

We will continue to apply three day suspensions to students who are caught vaping at school or while in school uniform. Recently, we have had two or three students discovered coming out of a single use toilet at the same time. These students are clearly



involved in unacceptable behaviour. The nature of this may not be clear but their actions are designed to hide what they are doing. From Monday, any students caught congregating in a group in a single use toilet will be placed in our in-school suspension and will be required to provide a written explanation of their actions. Their parents / carers will be contacted.

CoVid Safety
